The Chicago/Turabian style of citing sources is generally used when citing sources for humanities papers, and is best known for its requirement that writers place bibliographic citations at the bottom of a page or at the end of a paper.

Use one-inch margins and continue the header from the rest of your paper. Title the page References, centered at the top (no bold, italics, quotation marks, etc.). References should be in a hanging indent format, meaning that the first line of each reference is set flush left and subsequent lines are indented, like this:

MLA In-Text Citations (Modern Language Association) Indicating your citations in the essay's body is meant to be as short and as readable as possible. It's quite different from the references pages where you indicate tons of details about the source. Your in-text citation is a link to the works cited page at the end of your paper.

How to Cite an Article in an Essay — MLA and APA In-Text

Create a list of references, one for each item cited in the paper, in a section called "References". This section goes at the end of your paper. The references are to be alphabetized by the first author's last name, or (if no author is listed) the organization or title.
