The most common now are 1920 x 1080 (1080p, or “Full HD ”) or 3840 x 2160 (2160p, or “ UHD ” or “ 4K ”). Lesser-used, smaller resolutions include 1280x720 (720p, also an HD format), or 720 x 480 or 720 x 576 (“ SD ”). Higher resolution means more detail, and because it has more pixels, more color information.

1080p (1920×1080 pixels; also known as Full HD or FHD, and BT.709) is a set of HDTV high-definition video modes characterized by 1,920 pixels displayed across the screen horizontally and 1,080 pixels down the screen vertically; the p stands for progressive scan, i.e. non-interlaced. The term usually assumes a widescreen aspect ratio of 16:9, implying a resolution of 2.1 megapixels.

A 360p resolution video is made up of 360 lines stacked one on top of another, with each line being 480 pixels wide and this is what it means when people say a video's resolution is 480 x 360. It is the Current base resolution in YouTube, labelled as "360p".

In cinematography, the 2K resolution exists, and it refers to 2048 × 1080. However, in the consumer market, it would be considered 1080p. 4K Video Formats: What Supported Formats of 4K Resolution

In digital video, resolution means the number of pixels displayed on screen. Technically speaking there are two types of resolution: Spatial resolution means the width and height of the displayed image, measured in pixels. In other words, the total number of pixels contained in each individual frame. Temporal resolution means the frame rate (number of frames shown per second), i.e. "resolution over time".
